

2022 North Country Circuit

NCC's mission is to encourage people to get out and enjoy their horses and to help promote Open and Fun or Schooling Shows and other Events.

NCC members collect points by attending ANY Open horse show or event in Northern Alberta in 2022 (Red Deer area and North)

Shows and Events that qualify are:

- All open shows
- Schooling and Fun Shows
- Obstacle Events such as Cowboy Challenges, and the low-key Obstacle Events

Exclusions to this are the following shows:

- Reining Shows, Working Cow Horse, Cutting
- Dressage, Jumping or Three-Day Eventing
- Gymkhana Events
 - Note: any Open Shows that include the above events would qualify and points for these classes would be accumulated under the Auxiliary Classes. (see below)
- Breed or breed affiliated shows offering "All Breed" classes.
- 4H achievement day shows.

NCC Member fills in Show Form with class placings while at the show and has the show secretary sign off. Similar to the PAC program.

- Members record every class they enter. They get 1 point for each class.
- Members will record their placing in each class if they placed. They will be awarded 6 points for first place, 5 points for second place etc.

The show committee of the qualifying events and shows has **zero** responsibility, other than to sign the NCC member's sheet at the end of the day. Stating that they were actually there.

It will be the NCC members responsibility to collect and submit the show forms. The NCC secretary will tally points once received.

Year End Prize Categories

If you attend a show whose classes do not fit in with the NCC categories your points will be awarded in your category. For example: If a 12-year-old rider is in a class for 17 and under their points will be applied to the 13 and under category. If a 15-year-old enters an open class their points will be applied to the 14 to 17 category.

Halter Horse. All ages, all sexes.

- All horses 2 and under
- All horses 3 and over

In-Hand Classes including Showmanship and In-Hand Trail or Obstacle classes

Riding Classes

Divisions - Youth (Under 13), Intermediate (14-17), Adult (18+)

Combined points from English Equitation, English Pleasure, Western Equitation, Western Pleasure.

Note: Could be split into English and Western per age division **IF** Membership warrants.

Trail and Obstacle Classes.

Divisions - Youth (Under 13), Intermediate (14-17), Adult (18+)

These divisions will include participation in events like Cowboy Challenge and various Obstacle events.

Road Warrior

Prize for who ever attends the most Open Horse Shows and Events in Northern Alberta in 2022.

- Recognition for going out and supporting local shows.

Auxiliary Classes

Prize for who ever showed in the most auxiliary classes over the season at the local shows and events they attended. To be noted on their show form. Auxiliary classes could be: Ranch Riding, Reining, Stake classes, dressage, working equitation toilet paper pairs and other games etc.

- To encourage riders to try something new!

Membership Fees

Adults, 18 and over \$35.00, Youth, 17 and under \$20.00, Family, 2 or more people, any age \$50.00

Points will be awarded for all shows attended after membership is paid.
